Seth Densen Announces Candidacy for Newly Formed Florida House District 93 Seat

Wellington, Florida, 04/01/2022 – Seth Densen, local advocate, educator, and social worker, announces he's running for Florida State House of Representatives District 93. After the redistricting process, Seth is the first candidate to officially file for the seat.

Densen has over 20 years of experience in social services and over half a decade in child welfare services. He has seen firsthand the need in Florida for reforms related to education funding, child trafficking, elder and child abuse, adoption, LGBTQ+ equality, and women's rights.

Ready to be your advocate in District 93, Seth Densen is a fresh-faced Democrat who will take on issues facing our district and our state. Seth has worked in state government and became an advocate for many of the vulnerable in Palm Beach County, including children and the elderly.

"I have a track record for standing up for what I believe in and defending Palm Beach County and its residents," said Densen. "We need leaders that will change the tide and speak up for those who are repeatedly silenced. Let me elevate your voice to make lasting change in our state and secure a hopeful future."

Densen's platform will work across the aisle to create lasting change on critical issues such as education, child welfare, homelessness, mental health, infrastructure, drowning prevention, and firearm safety. But most of all, he wants to provide support and resources to the nearby communities to eliminate some of the most destructive issues today.

As the representative for District 93, Densen plans to advocate for child abuse and human trafficking reforms. Florida ranks 3rd in the Nation and Palm Beach County and 3rd in the state for its prevalence of human trafficking. In addition, he will promote adoption and push for modifications to the foster care system.

With over 1,500 homeless individuals in Palm Beach County, Densen pledges to work with colleagues in Florida's State House to improve accessibility to affordable housing, provide more resources for domestic and family violence victims and improve access to healthcare.

Crumbling infrastructure is also a considerable concern of the campaign as it is one of the greatest threats facing Florida and the nation today. As we prepare for more extreme weather

and a growing population, Densen will ensure our state has a robust infrastructure to withstand future challenges.

On the same note, he will ensure that support and resources are provided to the community to eliminate some of the most destructive issues present today. To prevent future crises, he will work now to repair infrastructure, provide affordable housing, provide better access to quality healthcare, and make resources more widespread for all individuals.

Densen summarizes this in his own words: "We can fight for the long-term safety and health of all of our citizens. We can fight for quality education. We can fight for better streets and homes. Palm Beach County, Florida needs representatives that will look beyond politics and come up with thought-out, real solutions for the people that will continue to impact the area for generations to come positively."

From a young age, Seth knew he wanted to help others as a social worker, being a voice for the silent. However, he didn't have the easiest childhood. Seth was born prematurely, and it was clear that Seth was a fighter from the start. As a kid, he wore hearing aids with big glasses, and in grammar school, he was diagnosed with a learning disability. This made him an easy target for bullies, and he understands many of the issues youth today face.

Experiencing all of this gave him a determination to succeed, and he now holds a Bachelor's degree in Family Studies and a Master's Degree in Social Work. In addition, he is an adjunct instructor at Florida Atlantic University's Phyllis and Harvey Sandler School of Social Work and a social worker at Jupiter Medical Center.

When he isn't working or spending time campaigning, he is with his family. Sam, his wife Pam, and their three children can be found volunteering their time with various organizations in the Palm Beach County area.
